Please list relevant Kappa Psi experience: During my Regency at Delta Eta, we were given the opportunity to host Winter Assembly for the first time in years. As a professional event planner, I naturally joined the Assembly Planning Committee where I was in charge of the logistics for the banquet, execution of registration and promotion of the conference, as well as overall brainstorming and planning of the Assembly. As Chair of Legislative Committee have implemented initiatives to guarantee the documentation of risk management contracts of all brothers in the province as well as a central location for updated ordinances from our chapters, reaching out to the Grad Chapters as I served on the executive board as Parliamentarian.
